## TO VACCINATE OR NOT TO VACCINATE?

Immunization rates are decreasing in many areas and more and more parents are declining vaccines for their children. Parents have concerns regarding the safety of vaccines as well as a lack of knowledge about the health risks involved when children contract these preventable diseases. There is a growing number of physicians in practice today that have never seen or cared for patients with measles or mumps. The first presentation, **“Measles, Mumps and Pertussis: Back to the Future?”** will provide information about recent outbreaks of measles, mumps and pertussis in the U.S. and will educate physicians about the impact of these diseases in children and how to talk to parents about their vaccination against them. The second presentation, **“Lessons Learned from the H1N1 Pandemic: A Pediatric Story”** describes the impact of influenza on children during the 2009-10 H1N1 Influenza A pandemic and outlines the current recommendations on prevention.

**Format** - Meeting format will be lecture with case presentation. A question and answer session will conclude the Meeting. This activity will encompass the following desirable physician attributes: Patient Care, Medical Knowledge, Professionalism, Practice-based Learning and Improvement and Inter-Personal and Communication Skills.

### Speaker



**Wilbert H. Mason, Jr., MD, MPH, FAAP**

Professor of Clinical Pediatrics, Keck School of Medicine, University of Southern California (USC); Attending Physician Division of Infectious Disease, Children's Hospital, Los Angeles (CHLA)

Dr. Mason's (MD, University of California Irvine, 1970; MPH [Epidemiology], University of California Los Angeles, 1995) research focus has been in Kawasaki disease. More recently, he has been involved in the implementation of evidence based medicine through the use of clinical practice guidelines in the hospital setting. He has also been active in the study and promotion of medical safety in pediatrics, once serving as the Chief Medical Quality officer at CHLA. He has participated in the Child Health Accountability Initiative of the Child Health Corporation of America since its inception in 1997 and was Co-Medical Director in 2001- 2003. He is a Past President of Chapter 2, District IX, of the American Academy of Pediatrics and long-time LAPS member.
